PAINT (tubes, artist-quality paints such as Windsor & Newton, Sennelier, Holbein, etc.)

Alizarin Crimson
Rose Dore
Cadmium orange
Cadmium yellow
Hooker's green
Cerulean blue
Ultramarine blue
Dioxazine purple
Burnt umber
Davy's grey
Payne's grey
Neutral tint
Sepia

PALETTE (do not buy a travel palette)

Look for a rectangular plastic palette with wells around the perimeter and mixing area in the center. Palettes can be purchased online at Jerry's ArtARama, Dick Blick, or Cheap Joes

Richeson Covered Palette	15" x 12"
Dick Blick covered palette	15" x 12"
Robert E. Wood Palette	16" x 12"
Tom Jones Watercolor Palette	17" x 12"

BRUSHES Round #'s 2, 4, & 8 1/2" flat synthetic. (Kolinsky sable most expensive, synthetic less expensive)

PAPER a good quality paper is very important.

Arches watercolor block, 140-lb weight, cold press texture. You choose the size you are comfortable with.

MISCELLANEOUS SUPPLIES 2H or HB pencil, eraser, Schminke masking fluid in tube, set of scrubbers, roll of Bounty towels, plastic water container
