Materials needed:

PAPER

- Essential—white paper drawing pad– 11×14 " and an optional bigger pad (18×24 "), also purchase a newsprint pad, 11×14 " for quick sketching You can explore other papers as well, such as colored pastel paper, watercolor or other paper.
- Sketch book for personal use

DRAWING MATERIALS

- A few ebony drawing pencils (Prismacolor Ebony is excellent), or other graphite pencils with the specific numbers of 4B, 6B or 8B.
- One or two black charcoal pencils. We will be using some color as well

Please consider getting any of the following: conte, watercolor pencils (many students love these), sharpie pens (fine point), white charcoal pencil, chalk or pastel, black tempera paint or ink. We will have one project that uses ink or black tempera paint.

- One paint brush (or more if you like to use water based mediums)
- Several sticks of vine charcoal (soft), and compressed charcoal (soft)
- Kneaded eraser and hard plastic eraser
- Pencil sharpener
- Blending sticks (optional)
