

# Introduction to Drawing with Oscar Peterson

The supplies listed below are suggestions. Beginning students should bring/use whatever they already have (or buy as little as possible) and I'll help them determine what additional supplies are needed.

## Recommended Supplies:

**Pencils** *\*\*you can choose graphite, charcoal or both\*\**

### Graphite

pencils: 2H, HB, 2B, 4B, 6B

### Charcoal

General's Charcoal pencils: (2B, 4B, 6B or soft, medium, hart)

Soft Vine (or willow) Charcoal sticks

General's White Charcoal pencil, chalk, or white hard pastel (no oil pastels)

### Paper

Newsprint pad 11x14, or 14x17 (for quick sketches)

100lb or 120lb Drawing paper (or pad, 11x14, or 14x17) - white or colored paper

Canson Mi Teintes drawing paper (Moonstone, Felt) *\*\*for charcoal drawing\*\**

### Erasers

Kneaded Eraser

Plastic Eraser

### Additional Supplies

Sharpening knife/blades (Mat knife, X-acto, etc.)

Sandpaper (medium grit 100, or 120 – to sharpen pencils)

Blending stump

Drawing board (large enough to fit paper)

Binder clips (or spring clamps) *\*\*if drawing board does not have clamps\*\**

Paper towels

Dust mask (if you're sensitive to charcoal dust)
